Nays Baghai is an independent filmmaker and underwater cameraman based in Sydney, Australia. Inspired by David Attenborough, Martin Scorsese and Stanley Kubrick as a youngster, Nays commenced his filmmaking career in 2013, and his passion has not wavered since.

As a storyteller, Nays is drawn to character-driven stories in the documentary and science fiction genres, and his disciplines include directing, producing, writing, cinematography and editing. As a videographer, he has a strong background in the corporate, diving and music sectors, and can work both autonomously and in filmmaking teams. He is known for his professionalism, attention to detail, versatility and enthusiasm, and currently works as the Creative Director of Running Cloud Productions.

Nays is also one of Australia's few underwater cinematographers who is experienced in both freediving, scuba diving and rebreather diving. He can dive to 40m both with and without tanks, can hold his breath for five minutes, and is experienced in shark and cold water diving.
